Summer term: Explorers/Shanghai

<u>Maths</u>

We will be looking at multiplication and division and fractions of a number.

Science: Summer 1 - Plants

We will be learning about:

- Different parts of the plant
- Parts of a tree
- Trees in my local area

Summer 2 - Growing and cooking

We will be learning about:

- Where our food comes from
- How to be sustainable
- Growing our own vegetables.

<u>Summer 1 History - How have explorers changed</u> <u>the world?</u>

This half term we will be learning about explorers from around the world;

We will be focussing on:

- Explaining what explorers do
- Thinking about what equipment and transport an explorer will need
- Naming important explorers (e.g. Christopher Columbus, Dame Ellen MacArthur, Matthew Henson and Mary Kingsley)
- Different coats of arms for significant people.
- Sequencing events on a timeline and use this to retell the story.

<u>Summer 2 - Geography - What is it like to live in</u> <u>Shanghai?</u>

This half term we will be learning about where we live and exploring what the weather is like;

We will be focussing on:

- Human and physical features in the UK and China
- Naming the continent we live in
- Using an Atlas to locate the UK and China.
- Comparing Shanghai to their locality.

We are learning about 'Relationships' this half term. We are looking at different families and how we can show friendship to others.

After half term we will be focussing on changes. We will discuss how we change form Reception to Year 1 and understand that changes can be good
